### FAQ

#### 1. How can I send my Application?

#### 2. After I submit my March of Dimes Canada Assistive Mobile Technology Initiative Application, when will I hear from you?

An acknowledgement of your application is issued immediately via email to each applicant. Greater Vancouver Area applicants will receive notice via email by February 19, 2016.

#### 3. I only have part of the required documents for my Application. Can I submit what I've got now, and send the rest later?

In order to have your Application reviewed, a complete package must be submitted. If you are not able to submit all your documents by the deadline of February 12, 2016, your application cannot be considered.

#### 4. I already have a tablet that I like to use, but have limited software/apps that assist me. Can I still apply?

No, we are not providing separate software.

#### 5. Which apps will be provided?

An attempt will be made to match the apps to the recipients' identified needs. The range of apps available will be considered up to a maximum value of \$250.

#### 6. Do applicants need to have a prior assessment by an Occupational Therapist or other professional?

No, it might help determine the best solution, but it is not essential. The individual can specify his or her needs and a volunteer with the expertise at March of Dimes Canada will assist in selecting the appropriate technology.

**7. Will March of Dimes Canada fund the internet access or data plan to operate the tablet?**

No, March of Dimes Canada is only providing the hardware and software and helping to set up the device for each successful applicant. The individual has to provide their own internet access.
