### BC DEVELOPMENT SLEDGE HOCKEY COACH

The BC Development Sledge Hockey Coach will volunteer part time October 2017- April 2018 focusing on the development of the athletes at the intermediate level in the province of BC incorporating an approach that reflects the LTAD for Sledge Hockey. The coach position is on a volunteer basis but all incidentals will be covered and a coaching honorarium may be provided. The coach can expect to have significant face to face contact time with athletes being coached and evaluating the athletes on a regular basis. The position will require touching base with athlete's off-ice and attending on-ice practices, relevant camps, and relevant tournaments (including travel). The term of the contract is until April 2018, at which time the position will be reviewed. The time commitment is 5-10 hours per week depending on programs commitments.

Coaches' duties include but are not limited to:

- Evaluating athletes in physical and technical elements
- Building and implementing stage appropriate training plans
- Keeps detailed record of training programs
- Receive and monitor monthly training reports from the BC Development Team athletes
- Submit post-camp reports and evaluations to the Sport Development Coordinator / Executive Director within one month of the completion of the event.
- Collaborate with other staff on a written annual plan for the Provincial BC Development Team
- Provides ongoing support for athletes and other coaches working with regional sledge hockey programs  
Assists in the recruitment and development of new clubs, athletes, and coaches.
- Attends BC Development ID Camp, BC Development Team specific practices, BC Development Team training camps and the Canadian Western Sledge Hockey Tournament in Alberta as the Coach
- Works with SportAbility staff to coordinate and present training camps and other provincial team activities.
- Is a member of the BC Development Team selection committee for their sport
- Demonstrate an ongoing commitment to continued educational development in sport

#### *Required*

- NCCP level 1/2 Hockey Canada Coaching Course
- Must be a current member or being willing to become member of SportAbility and remain in good standing
- Have experience with hockey or Para-Sport athletes
- Criminal Record Check when requested
- Knowledge of the Long Term Athlete Develop Model.

#### *Recommended*

- Have several years of experience with hockey or Para-Sport athletes at an intermediate or competitive level
- Be a member of the Coaches' Association of Canada
- Emergency First Aid CPR C certificate
